Acting 1 (60 minutes, ages 10-12)

Taught by Jennifer Rockwell

This will be an ongoing class to help sharpen students' acting skills. Each class will consist of acting activities & improv games to guide each student in learning to react vs. act, and how to use your voice and body when acting.
Tuition is \$20/class, \$35/2 classes, \$50/3 classes, \$60/4 classes, \$75/5 classes

Wednesday 4:00pm - 5:00pm

Acting 2 (60 minutes, ages 13-18)

Taught by Jennifer Rockwell

This class will focus on strengthening your craft. From improv and comedy, to monologues and audition prep, to scene work and acting within a song. *Tuition is \$60/4 week session*

Session 2 - Scene Work (Feb 9th - Mar 2nd)
Session 3 - Acting the Song (Mar 9th - Mar 30th)
Session 4 - Improv (April 5th - April 26th)

Ballet (60 minutes, ages 12+)

This class will consist of a warmup, bar, floor combinations, and diagonal work across the floor that will focus on the fundamentals of Ballet with a strong emphasis on technique.

Hip Hop (60 minutes, ages 13+)

Hip Hop is a high-energy, fun dance style that mixes sharp and soft movements. Learn how to listen to the music behind the lyrics and hit every part of your body on the beat.

Jazz - Advanced (60 minutes, ages 13+)

Taught by Andy Kowalczewski

Jazz uses many of the techniques from other forms of dance to allow students to bring out their individual dance style and originality. Class will not only focus on dance technique but also on stage presence and the performance aspect of jazz. *Tuition is \$20/class, \$35/2 classes, \$50/3 classes, \$60/4 classes, \$75/5 classes*

Thursday 4:00pm - 5:00pm

Tap (60 minutes, ages 12+)

Taught by Shaina Schwartz

Classes consist of warm-up, progressions and combinations. Beginner Tap is for dancers with 0-5 years of Tap experience. Advanced Tap is for dancers with 6+ years of Tap experience.

Tuition is \$20/class, \$35 for classes, 3 week month is \$50, 4 week month is \$60, 5 week month is \$75

Beginner: Wednesday 4:00pm - 5:00pm

Advanced: Wednesday 6:00pm - 7:00pm

Lyrical - Advanced (60 minutes, ages 13+)

Taught by Isabella Baer (Bean)

Lyrical is a dance style that blends ballet and jazz dance. A lyrical dancer uses movement to express strong emotions such as love, joy and anger. Classes consist of warm-up, isolation exercises, diagonal work across the floor, and combinations. Prior jazz experience required.

Tuition is \$20/class, \$35/2 classes, \$50/3 classes, \$60/4 classes, \$75/5 classes

Musical Theater Dance

Musical Theater Dance is the study of Broadway dance and dance styles, relying heavily on knowledge from Ballet and Jazz. This class will include center warm-up stretches, isolations, and core strengthening, followed by across-the-floor technique and choreography. Students will also learn numbers from Broadway shows.

Tuition is \$20/class, \$35/2 classes, \$50/3 classes, \$60/4 classes, \$75/5 classes

Beginner Voice Class (45 minutes, ages 9-12)

Taught by Christina DeMaio

In this small group class, your beginning singer will learn accessible tools of vocal technique to help them explore and expand their range and establish healthy habits that will serve them as they grow. We will learn foundational music literacy skills (such as rhythm and solfege) to help them learn the songs they love most! Group and solo singing will take place.

Tuition is \$45-\$75/month (depending on the length of the month)

JR Rep Company (60 minutes, ages 10-13)

JR Rep Company will meet each week and explore all aspects of Musical Theatre. Students will learn to act through song and dance, play theater games, do Improv, build characters, and work together as a team.

Tuition is \$250 (Jan 15th - May 21st)

Saturday 11am - 12pm

Intro. to Acting (45 minutes, ages 6-7)

Taught by Maryann Williams

This class will introduce the fundamentals of acting. The students will learn theater terminology, improvisation activities and will incorporate scene work to grow confidence in their abilities.

Tuition is \$60 per 4-week session

Thursday at 4:00pm

Musical Theater Acting (45 minutes, ages 8-9)

Taught by Maryann Williams

In Musical theatre acting students will grow in their knowledge of musicals from the Golden Age to Contemporary, incorporating scene work, along with exploring character motivation through music and lyrics.
